<b>Cottonwood Canyon</b> - remote scenic canyon, rocky with flash floods possible, no bikes in wilderness areas	8.1
<b>Prospector</b> - long single-track trail, sandy in sections	7.2
<b>High Grade</b> - rocky single-track connector to Prospector	0.4
<b>Heath</b> - rugged canyon adjoining Cottonwood canyon	4.0
<b>Red Reef</b> - rugged backcountry canyon route, flash floods	5.9
<b>Red Reef East</b> - easy, old two-track access road	0.9
<b>Anasazi</b> - easy hike leads to Anasazi pit houses and archeological ruins	0.5
<b>Miano</b> - short, west connector trail to Anasazi trail	0.1
<b>Metate</b> - short, east connector trail to Anasazi trail	0.1
<b>Silver Reef</b> - short climb on slickrock, dinosaur tracks	0.2

Trail Description	One-way Distance (Miles)
<b>White Reef</b> - easy two-track loop with Leeds Reef	1.7
<b>Leeds Reef</b> - easy two-track loop with White Reef	1.4
<b>Cordura</b> - easy, short trail leads to movie set remnants and historic homestead ruins	0.3
<b>Adams</b> - short, easy trail near historic Adams house	0.1
<b>Grubstake</b> - easy, short, two-track connector trail	0.2
<b>McMullin</b> - connector between homestead & White Reef	0.1
<b>Adit</b> - easy, short two-track connector trail	0.2
<b>Tipple</b> - old two-track with Leeds creek crossing	1.0
