

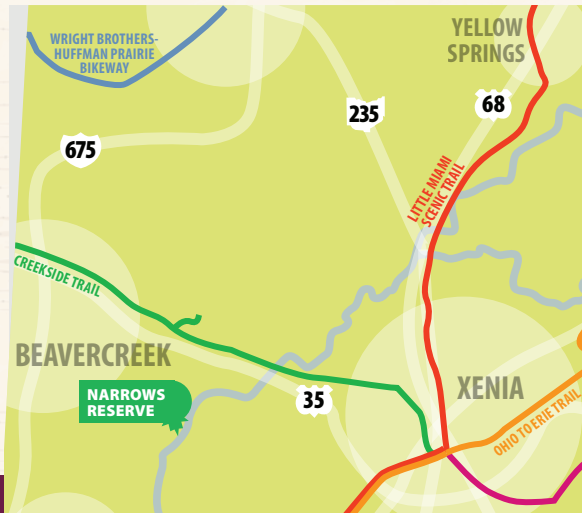
Narrows Reserve

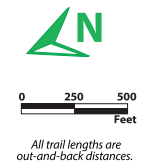
CANOING AND CAMPING!
