



Bike 4 Trails

Bicycle Safety

- Bike trails are surfaced with fine limestone or similar materials. They are not designed for high speed travel. They can become soft and wet, can erode quickly during heavy rains and are subject to animal damage.
- Wear bright clothing by day, white or reflective clothing are recommended.
- Use a light and reflectors at night.
- Keep your bike under full control at all times.
- Keep your bike, especially the brakes, in safe condition.
- Slow down and use voice or bell to warn others as you pass.
- Be considerate of bikers coming your way, especially on hills.
- Keep right and allow room for oncoming traffic to pass. • Keep at least two bike lengths between riders.

Trail Passes are required for bicyclists 16 years and older prior to using the trail.

Please remember, put litter in its place.

Please carry out your garbage and recyclables.

In emergency, all areas are covered by 911.
