



Holland Falls National Recreation Trail #416

Distance: It is 1.6 miles from the trailhead to Holland Falls.

USGS Quad: Holland Lake Difficulty: Easy


Ending Elevation: 4,800 ft at base of Falls Beginning Elevation: 4,050 ft at the TH

Directions: From Highway 83 turn east onto Holland Lake Road #44 near mile marker 35. Follow this road about 4 miles to the end, past the day use site and campground, to access the trailhead.


Season: The trail is normally free of snow by the end of April.

Regulations: This trail is open to hiking only.

Trail Description: The Holland Falls National Recreation Trail is 1.6 miles long and climbs about 750 feet. It begins at the junction of East Holland Lake Connector Trail #415 not far from the parking lot. This easy trail shadows the shoreline of Holland Lake and then gradually climbs to the foot of Holland Falls.
