

Wildlife Watching

4,095 acres of riparian woodlands, wetlands, marsh and farm land attract deer, wild turkey, waterfowl, hawks, owls, osprey, bald eagle and a wide variety of species. The Grand Kankakee Marsh was known world wide for its waterfowl

Neighboring Land

Four wetland Conservation Areas are administered through this property. Ask for information at the office.

- Turkey Foot Wetland Conservation Area (153 acres)
- Round Lake Wetland Conservation Area (134 acres)
- Koontz Lake Wetland Conservation Area (58 acres)
- Dick Blythe Wetland Conservation Area (200 acres)

Sign-in is not required for scouting, fishing, hiking or wildlife watching.

Wild berries, nuts and spring and fall mushrooms may be gathered from the property. Mushroom hunters may not enter field until noon during spring turkey season.
