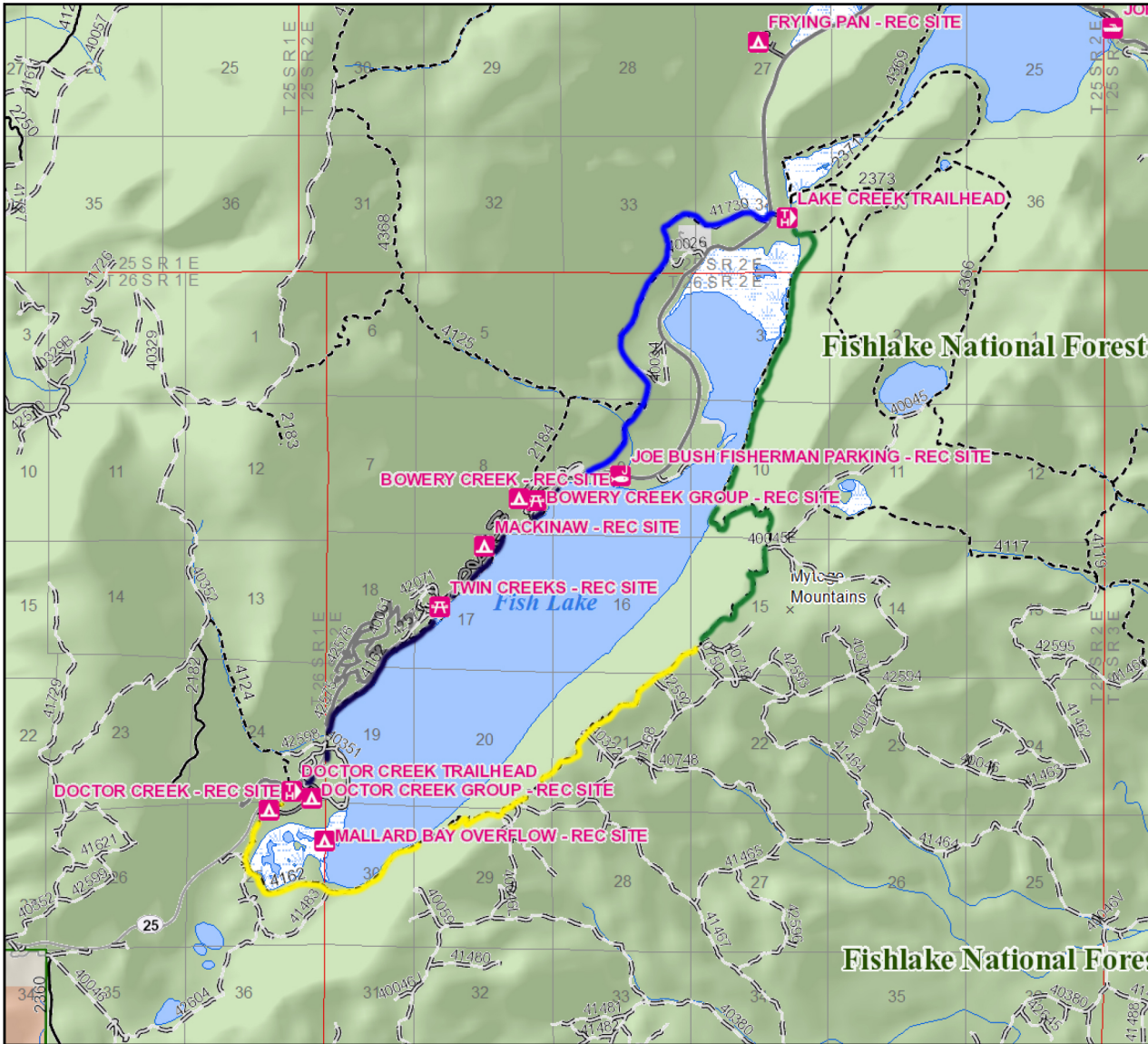


LAKESHORE NATIONAL RECREATION MAP
