

## **Lost Cabin Lake Trail #150 (National Recreation Trail)**

**Managed Use(s):** Hike, mountain bike, and horse.

**Difficulty:** Easy grade

**Trail Length:** 3.4 miles

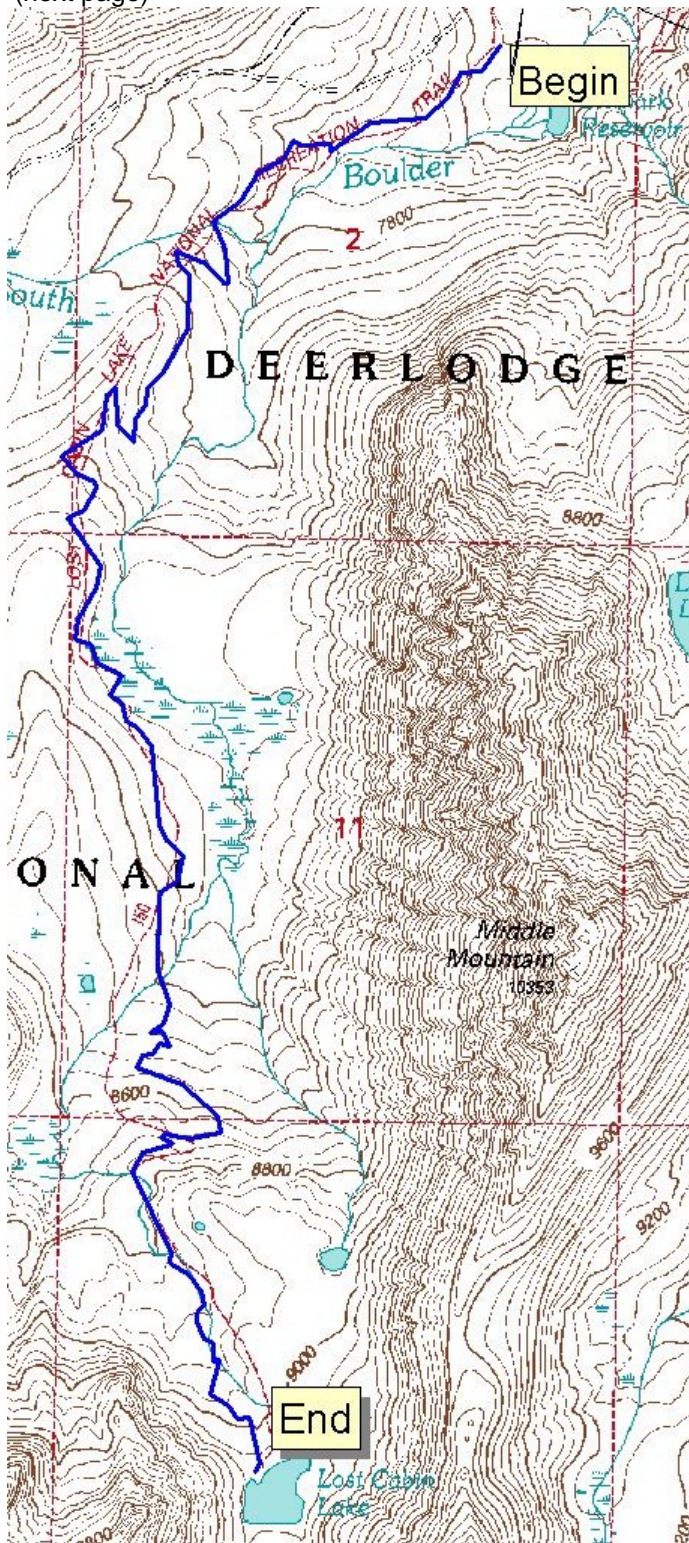
### **Attractions and Considerations**

The Lost Cabin Lake Trail begins at the west end of Bismark Reservoir. The peaks surrounding the lake reach elevations above 10,000 feet. Mountain goats can often be seen on the cliffs to the south and east of the lake. Depending on snow, the trail is usually open from July 1 to the middle of October. Snowdrifts on the trail may be abundant during years of late thaws.

### **Trailhead Directions**

From Interstate 90, take the Cardwell exit seven miles east of Whitehall. Take Montana Highway 359 south for approximately five miles to the South Boulder Road #107. Travel south on Road #107 for approximately 15 miles to the trailhead at Bismark Reservoir. Passenger cars can drive this road, but the last two miles are best traveled by high clearance vehicles.
