VISION

This Water Trail will be an easily accessible recreation resource for residents and visitors.

This Water Trail will contribute to the economic development of Wood County and the surrounding region.

The Mid-Ohio Valley will become a nationally recognized destination for canoeing, kayaking, paddle boarding and other non-motorized water activities, resulting in improved communities and a strengthened economy.

GOALS

1. Enhance economic tourism development in the Greater Parkersburg area by encouraging and enabling visitors and residents to enjoy canoeing and kayaking on the Ohio River, the Little Kanawha River, and the many other rivers, streams and lakes in the Mid-Ohio Valley.
 - Develop a Water Trail marketing and promotional plan.
2. Develop more access points for the Water Trail.
 - Work with Water Trail communities to include Water Trail access and amenity development in their community and economic development planning.
 - Mobilize and organize Water Trail communities and citizens to implement their Water Trail-related community and economic development plans.
3. Work with agencies and communities to provide water safety educational information and signage at Water Trail access points.
4. Develop, with partners, interpretive materials and tools to educate Water Trail users about the area's scenic, natural, recreational, historical and engineering assets.
5. Build Collaboration.
 - Foster and nurture an environment of cooperation and collaboration among the many partners involved in the diverse aspects of creating and developing the Water Trail.
 - Develop supportive relationships among the communities along the Water Trail.
6. Plan future Ohio River Water Trail maintenance and development.
 - Create, in cooperation with partners, sponsors and water trail communities, plans for developing the water trail and its amenities.
 - Develop maintenance strategies and agreements.
