VISION

- 2. Develop more access points for the Water Trail.
 - Work with Water Trail communities to include Water Trail access and amenity development in their community and economic development planning.
 - Mobilize and organize Water Trail communities and citizens to implement their Water Trail-related community and economic development plans.
- 3. Work with agencies and communities to provide water safety educational information and signage at Water Trail access points.
- 4. Develop, with partners, interpretive materials and tools to educate Water Trail users about the area's scenic, natural, recreational, historical and engineering assets.
- 5. Build Collaboration.
 - Foster and nurture an environment of cooperation and collaboration among the many partners involved in the diverse aspects of creating and developing the Water Trail.
 - Develop supportive relationships among the communities along the Water Trail.
- 6. Plan future Ohio River Water Trail maintenance and development.
 - Create, in cooperation with partners, sponsors and water trail communities, plans for developing the water trail and its amenities.
 - Develop maintenance strategies and agreements.

TRAIL MAINTENANCE MANAGEMENT PLAN

- 1. WCATC will encourage trail users (and others) to report maintenance issues or concerns via the Trail web page.
- 2. WCATC will track all reported maintenance issues.
- 3. WCATC will report the maintenance concern to the co-sponsors, and to the owner of the issue.
- 4. WCATC will encourage the owner to correct the issue and to report when the maintenance issue is fixed.
- 5. If possible, WCATC will report back to the person who originally reported the concern the ongoing status and final resolution.
- 6. Web page for reporting issues will include phone numbers for entities managing access points.
