## THE GREAT Guernsey Trail

Take a leisurely stroll with your family or a relaxing 14-mile bike ride enjoying the solitude and beauty along this paved, low-grade path. The scenery along the way is unforgettable as you disappear into the serene woods.





In the spring, time you will be treated to abundant wildflowers and in the fall to the fiery autumn colors. Travel over four bridges; take the Coal Ridge Park & Trails connector trail to enjoy a secluded pond with benches, observation decks and additional unimproved trails.



- The Great Guernsey Trail is for walkers, equestrians and bicyclists only.
- No motor vehicles are permitted on the trail.
- The trail is seven miles long and stretches from Corduroy Road (63500 Corduroy Rd. Cambridge, Ohio 43725) east of Cambridge to Lore City (204 Main Street, Lore City, Ohio 43755).
- Paved parking is provided at the trail heads at Corduroy Rd and Lore City.
- Restrooms are located at the trails heads and along the trail.
- Lore City pavilion has handicap accessible parking and ramps into the pavilion
- Dog parks are located at both the Cambridge and Lore City ends of the trail and pet waste sanitation stations are installed along the length of the trail.

## Trail Heads

The Lore City trail head is accessible near Leatherwood Park at the northern end of the village.

The Corduroy Rd trail head is located  $\frac{1}{4}$  mile south of U.S. 40. Corduroy Rd intersects with U.S. 40 about  $\frac{3}{4}$  miles east of 1-77.
