

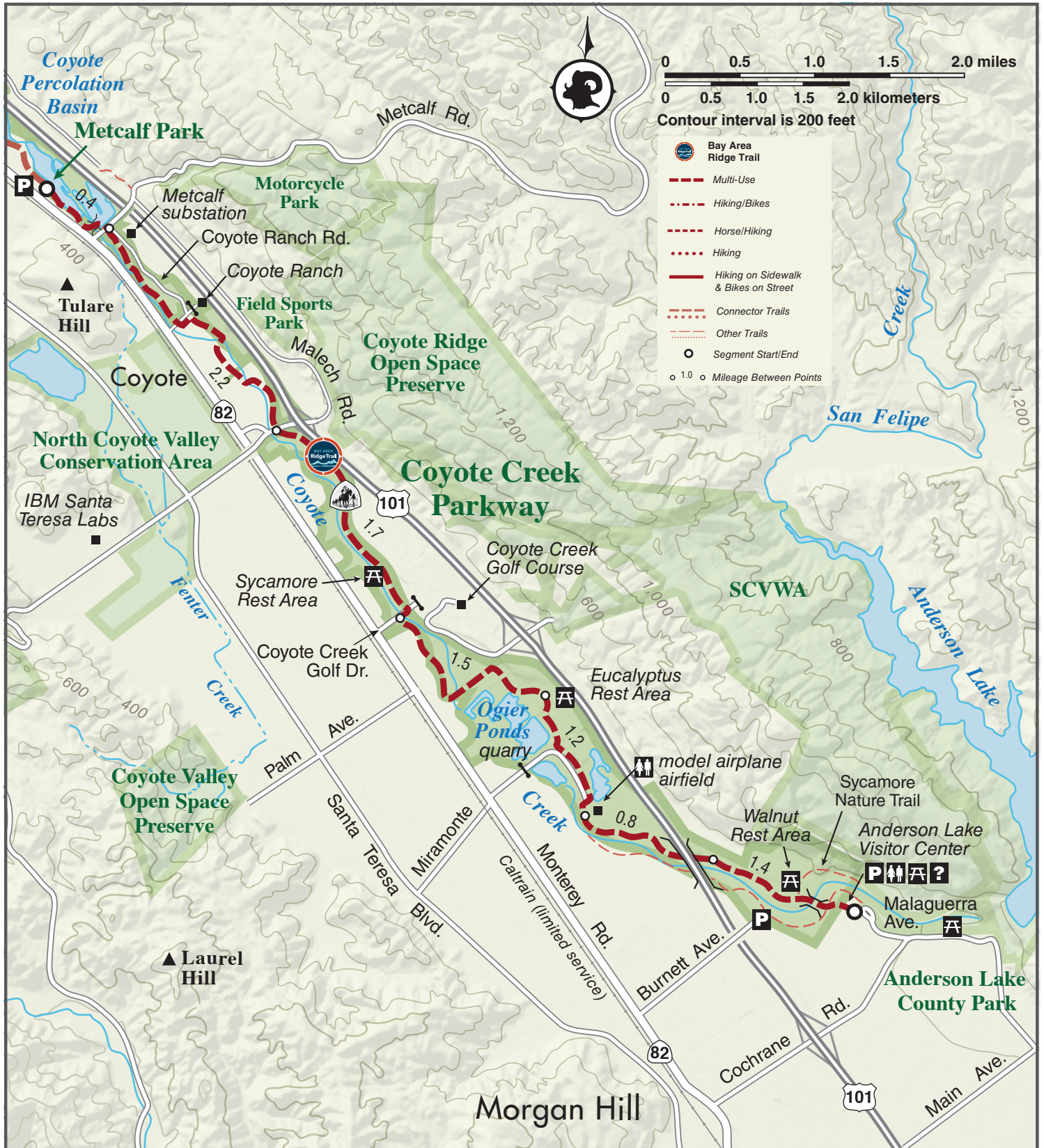

## Coyote Creek Parkway South

**From:** Metcalf Park in San José

**To:** Anderson Lake Visitor Center in Morgan Hill

**Length:** 9.2 miles one-way; car shuttle possible.

**Elevation Gain:** 150 feet one-way

**Accessibility:** Hikers, bicyclists, equestrians, and wheelchair users. Equestrians use alternative marked trail.

Take a creekside stroll or ride through the undeveloped broad Coyote Creek floodplain. Enjoy pleasant rest stops under large shade trees and awesome views of the nearby Coast Range. The trail provides an opportunity to appreciate what the Santa Clara Valley looked like before it was developed. The entire route follows a level paved trail (with a separate unpaved path for horses). Much of the trail is in the sun, so plan the trip for cooler weather.
